

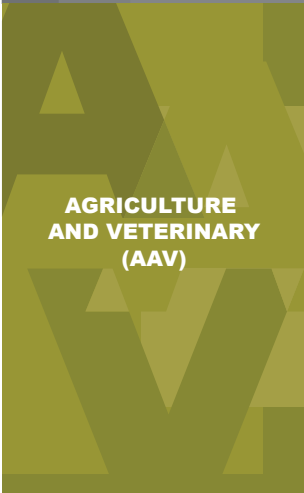
Definition of Package Categories

 ARTS AND SOCIAL SCIENCE (ANS)	Arts is the study of arts without specialising in any of the detailed fields. The discipline of Arts studies various aspects of human culture and civilisation. Social Science is one of the fields of knowledge that studies the society and social behaviour of humans. The discipline Social Sciences has a composition of various academic disciplines, which provides actual insight about the human and its association with the society.  BUSINESS AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (BAE)	A business is the study of the theory and practice of planning, directing, organising and coordinating the resources of private and public organisations and institutions. It's also defined as an organisation or enterprising entity engaged in commercial, industrial, or professional activities. The specialisation in Entrepreneurship offers a thorough and practical understanding of concepts, issues, techniques, approaches and resources for starting, acquiring and managing a business venture. Beyond the specialised areas, students will be exposed to broad knowledge of the domains of business so that they become business generalists who are well-versed in organising and managing resources.  CULINARY ARTS AND HOSPITALITY (CAH)	Services rendered to tourists/non-tourists encompassing food and beverages. Hospitality management refers to many different types of businesses including hotels, restaurants, casinos, resorts, airlines and tour agencies. Hospitality industry is related to restaurant and food service.  ENVIRONMENTAL AND HEALTH SCIENCE (EAH)	Environment is about learning the way we should live and how we can develop sustainable strategies to protect the environment. It helps individuals to develop an understanding of living and physical environment, and how to resolve challenging environmental issues affecting nature. Health science encompasses a variety of sub-disciplines relates to the application of science to health. This inclusive of traditional and alternative medicine because humans have always needed to deal with illness. 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FOOD, CULTURE AND HERITAGE (FCH)	Relates to cultural values, food is a central identity marker, defining personality, social class, lifestyles, gender roles and relationships, from family, to community, to ethnic groups or nationality, changing through time and place. Culture heritage consists of 3 elements which are monument, groups of buildings and sites. - Monuments: architectural works, works of monumental sculpture and painting, - Groups of buildings: groups of separate or connected buildings which brings special value from the point of history view. - Sites: topographical areas. Overall, FCH encompassing the diverse elements of Food, Languages, Beliefs, Dance, Music, Lifestyle, Indigenous Culture, Historical Artefacts and Medicinal Values.	Example of activities / fields: - Food tasting, experience and history - Sharing of local taboo, accents, the way of greetings - Experience in ethnic dance, music, costume and lifestyle - Historical landmark or building - Archaeology - Homestay
LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION (LAC)	Language and communication is the study of structure and composition of various languages. It's also referring to activities or learning process that focus on improving language proficiency and interpersonal communication skills. LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT (LAM)	Leadership refers to activities or learning process that builds & improve the skills, abilities and confidence of individuals in becoming a leader. Leadership programme provides an insight on the fortes and positive aspects of a leaders in an organisation. Management is the study of planning, directing and operating the functions and activities of organisations and institutions. 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 NATURE AND ADVENTURE (NAA)	Nature refers to the phenomena of the physical world collectively including flora and fauna, animal and the landscape of the world. Adventures are characterised by some form of physical activity with an endurance element, consistent with being out of one's comfort zone. Often, they also include solitude time for reflection on the experience. Discover Malaysia and yourself while exploring the treasures of nature and its wildlife. Specially catered to adventure enthusiasts and nature lovers. This is where theory and practice combined and skills can be harnessed.  SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SAT)	Science encompasses the systematic study of the structure and behaviour of the physical and natural world through observation and experiment. Technology is the application of scientific knowledge for practical purposes.  SPORTS (SPT)	Sports is the study of techniques and skills in a chosen sport. It's involved with physical activities either indoor/outdoor Involvement of participants through activities, knowledge in sports.  AGRICULTURE AND VETERINARY (AAV)	The Agriculture and Veterinary category refers to structured travel experiences designed to educate participants about farming systems, agricultural practices, animal health, and veterinary sciences through immersive, hands-on, and observation-based activities. The focus is on promoting awareness, skills, and appreciation of agri-food systems, sustainable practices, animal welfare, and scientific applications in real-world agricultural and veterinary contexts.
